TREASURY: LIN SHAW REPORTED \$973.85 IN OUR ACCOUNT. MEMBERSHIPS: TICHIPS CURRENTLY HAS 46 MEMBERS. JOHN REPORTED HE MAD TAKEN OUT A COUPLE OF LOCAL ADDS HOPING TO BRING SOME OF THOSE 99'ERS OUT OF THE CLOSET AND DOWN TO OUR MEETINGS. THERE WERE A COUPLE OF NEW FACES AT THE MEETING AND 1 GUEST WHO OBTAINED A MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION. JOHN ALSO ASKED IF ANYONE OUT THERE WANTS TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE NEWSLETTER BY SUBMITTING TO HIM ARTICLES THAT DEAL WITH THE TI YOU WISH TO SHARE.

DISKS: HARRY REPORTED ON HIS TRIP TO THE CHICAGO FAIR. HE ALSO BROUGHT BACK SOME GOODIES. GROUP'S HARD AND FLOPPY CONTROLLER ISN'T OUT YET. (SO MUCH FOR THE CHRISTMAS WISH LIST). GARY BOWSER IS REPORTED TO BE SELLING A ADDON TO THE CONSOLE (9958 CHIP) THAT GIVES 80 COLUMNS. (\$179) DOESN'T SUPPORT A MOUSE BUT COMPATIBLE WITH MAJORITY OF 88 COLUMN SOFTWARE. COMPRODINE HAS A NEW UTILITY FOR THE ARTIST FAM, "ART CATALOGER". THIS MIFFTY PROGRAM WILL READ A DISK THAT CONTAINS FONTS AND INSTANCES THEN PRINT THEM OUT JUST LIKE THE CATALOGER FOR TIPS. THIS IS ONE UTILITY THAT SHOULD HAVE BEEN ON THE PLUS DISK. OBTAINED WAS FUNNEL WEB V4.31. THE PROGRAM HAS SOME MICE CHANGES FROM PREVIOUS VERSIONS. NOW DISK REVIEW HAS REPLACED DM1888 AND DISK PATCH. DISK REVIEW HAS THE SAME FEATURES THAT THE 88 COLUMN VERSION HAD IN OLDER VERSIONS. YOU CAN STILL ADD YOUR FAVORITE DISK MANAGER BUT WHY WAIST THE SPACE. THIS IS GOOD NEWS FOR THE SSSD DISK USER. THE PROGRAM ALSO IS FASTER THAN BEFORE. AGAIN THE BIGGEST CHANGE IS THE WINDOWING OF DISK REVIEW. ALSO REVIEWED BY HARRY WAS BACKSTEINI. THIS IS THE MOST ADVANCED BREAKOUT TYPE GAME FOR THE TI. YOU CAN SET UP YOUR SCREEN WITH PROVIDED MENU'S.

EXTENDED BASIC: LES WAS BACK AT THIS MONTH WITH A PROGRAM TO CONVERTS METERS TO FEET. YOU SHUTTER BUGS WOULD LOVE THIS ONE. YOU CAN TYPE IN THAT METER SCALE YOU ALWAYS FIND LISTED IN A PHOTO BOOK, TYPE THEM IN THE DATA STATEMENTS OF THE PROGRAM, AND THE PROGRAM WILL CONVERT THEM AND PRINT THEM OUT IN FEET. THE PRINT OUT IS CONDENSED SO YOU CAN SLIP THEM INTO YOUR POCKET AND NO MORE CONVERSIONS FOR DEPTH OF FIELD FOR THOSE FOCAL LENGTH SETTINGS.

#### LATEST MULTIPLAN (MP) NEWS

ONE OF THE FASCINATING THINGS ABOUT TEACHING, OR DOING CRAZY THINGS LIKE WRITING TUTORIALS, IS THAT THE WRITER/TEACHER INVARIABLY LEARNS AT LEAST A FEW THINGS IN THE PROCESS. SINCE MY FIRST ARTICLE LAST MONTH, I HAVE READ EMOUGH COMMENTS TO GET ME TO STRONGLY URGE ANYONE RUNNING MP ON A 99/4A TO PROMPTLY ORDER THE \$10 MP 4.0 UPGRADE FROM RAG SOFTWARE, 1032 CHANTENAY DRIVE, GLOUCESTER, ONTARIO, CANADA K1C 2K9. I FEEL COMFORTABLE RECOMMENDING THIS SIGHT UNSEEN BY ME DUE TO THE UNANIMOUS GLOWING COMMENTS ABOUT IT IN MANY SOURCES. ANOTHER INTERESTING DEVELOPMENT NEW TO ME WAS THE SLICK PRINTER CONTROL POSSIBLE IN OUR SPREADSHEETS, IN A VERSION THAT ACTUALLY DATES BACK TO 1985!! THIS, FOR EXAMPLE; LET ME TYPE A LARGE PRINT HEADING, STANDARD PRINT DATE, COMPRESSED PRINT BUNCHES OF DATA, AND STANDARD PRINT FILENAME REFERENCE AT BOTTOM. WE'LL GET INTO THAT AT A

RATHER LATER TIME; IF YOU CAN'T WAIT, GIVE ME A CALL IF YOU MUST.

#### FIRST EXAMPLE (CON'T.)

START UP THE PROGRAM AGAIN WITH MODULE/DISK (DISK GENEVE). THE BOTTOM (STATUS) LINE SHOULD SHOW TEMP (OUR INITIAL FILENAME), AND WE'LL BE READY TO "SELECT OPTION OR TYPE COMMAND LETTER". LET'S BEGIN BY LOADING IN OUR LITTLE SHEET FROM LAST TIME, WHICH WE MAMED UTILITY. HIT "T" FOR TRANSFER, "L" FOR LOAD, AND TYPE UTILITY TO LOAD IT FROM DRIVE 1 (PUTTING YOUR DATA DISK THERE FIRST). IF YOU HAVE MORE THAN 1 DRIVE, YOU CAN LEAVE YOUR PROGRAM DISK IN \$1 AND USE "T", "O" FOR OPTION, TAB (C1-A, 2, OR 1), AND TYPE DSK2 (OR OTHER DRIVE NUMBER) FOR SETUP. FROM THEN ON, ALL SAVES/LOADS WILL BE DONE USING THAT DISK. DISK 1 IS USED IF THERE IS NO ENTRY THERE. NOTE: IF YOU MAKE A MISTAKE IN ENTERING A COMMAND, YOU CAN ALWAYS BACK OUT OF IT WITH CT-C!

IF EVERYTHING HAS COOPERATED, YOU SHOULD BE LOOKING AT THE 4 ROW BY 4 COLUMN SHEET WE FINISHED WITH IN THE FIRST ARTICLE. YOU MAY NEED TO KNOW THAT SAVING AND LOADING IS CASE SENSITIVE; THAT IS, IF YOU CALLED THE FILE "UTILITY" AND TELL MP TO LOAD "UTILITY", IT WON'T WORK. IT'S PROBABLY EASIEST TO USE ALL CAPITAL LETTERS/NUMBERS FOR FILE NAMES TO AVOID THIS CONFUSION, BUT MP WILL ALLOW EITHER AS LONG AS YOU ARE EXACT.

LET'S MAKE OUR SHEET LOOK A BIT NEATER. YOU MAY HAVE NOTICED THAT WE DON'T KNOW WHAT THE NUMBERS WE HAVE IN FRONT OF US MEAN. WITH THE CURSOR IN RICI, SELECT "I" FOR INSERT, "R" FOR ROW, AND ENTER TO INSERT 1 ROW BEFORE THE PRESENT ROW #1. WHEN FINISHED, WE'LL HAVE A BLANK #1 ROW; THE FORMER #1 ROW WILL NOW BE #2, AND SO ON. OUR SUM IS NOW IN R5C4, NOT R4C4 AS BEFORE; NOTICE THE SUM IS STILL PERFORMED CORRECTLY. IN RICI, SELECT "A" (ALPHANUMERIC), AND TYPE "MONTH"; ARROW KEY TO RICZ WITHOUT HITTING ENTER, AND TYPE "KWH". NOTICE THAT THE MESSAGE LINE READS "ALPHA/VALUE:", AND THAT BY MOVING AROUND THE SHEET WITH ARROW KEYS MEANS WE DON'T HAVE TO CONSTANTLY HIT "A" FOR ALPHANUMERICS. PUT "DAYS" INTO RIC3, AND "COST" INTO RIC4. NOW WE CAN SEE WHAT THE NUMBERS REPRESENT BY THESE NEW COLUMN HEADINGS. WHILE WE'RE AT IT, YOU CAN SEE THAT THERE IS LOTS OF SPACE BETWEEN THE MONTHS IN C1 AND THE KWH IN C2. THAT'S CAUSED BY TWO THINGS, BOTH OF WHICH WE CAN CONTROL: COLUMN WIDTH AND JUSTIFICATION. WITHOUT ANY OTHER ACTION, MP SETS ALL COLUMNS TO A STANDARD, OR "DEFAULT", WIDTH OF 18 CHARACTERS. LET'S CHANGE C1 TO A WIDTH OF 6: FROM ANYWHERE IN C1, HIT "F" FOR FORMAT, "W" FOR WIDTH, AND TYPE IN "6" REPLACING THE "D" FOR DEFAULT NORMALLY USED BY MP. IN SHORT ORDER, C1 SHOULD BECOME ONLY 6 CHARACTERS WIDE. LET'S ALSO CHANGE THE DEFAULT JUSTIFICATION, OR THE WAY THE ENTERED ITEMS LINE UP. STANDARD FOR ALPHA INFO IS LEFT SIDE JUSTIFIED, NUMERIC IS RIGHT SIDE. FROM ANYWHERE ON THE SHEET, TYPE "F" FOR FORMAT, "C" FOR CELLS, "C1" TO TELL MP TO MAKE THIS CHANGE FOR EVERYTHING IN C1, TAB, AND "C" FOR CENTER JUSTIFY. THIS WILL CAUSE THE COL. HEADING "MONTH" AND EACH MONTH ENTRY (JUL, AUG, SEP) TO APPEAR CENTERED IN THE DEFINED WIDTH. YOUR SHEET SHOULD NOW LOOK LIKE THIS:

## TI TRICKS

BACKUPS When you are writing any program or document on any computer, it is a good practice to save your work every 15 minutes. If the power goes off or if the computer locks up, you will only loose the last fifteen minutes of work. I also make it a practice that when I finish a session on the computer that I first save the document or program to two different disks and then print out a listing of it. If something should happen to the disks, retyping the information is a lot faster than creating the material from memory.

TI-WRITER If you are using two different files and combining information, when you do a LoadFile (LF) or SaveFile (SF), you can put both filenames on the prompt line and TI-W will only use the first name. For example, DSK1.FILE1 DSK1.FILE2. By doing this you don't need to remember the other file name or retype it when you are finished with FILE1. If you want to insert or delete several spaces on sequential lines for formatting purposes such as a table of numbers, it can be done quite easily. First put a character which you haven't used anywhere else such as : on each line at the point that you want to insert or delete spaces. Turn off word wrap with CTRL 0. Then do a ReplaceString (RS) using the form /:/^^^/ to add spaces or the form /:^^^// to delete spaces. The replace string is also useful for removing the nonprinting characters such as CR or LF. The CTRL U function will work in the command line the same way it is used within a document to access the ASCII characters from 1 to 31.

EXTENDED BASIC While developing a new program, use line 90 REM DSK1.PROGO01 at the start of the program. Each time you save the program, do so by typing 90 then FCTN X. Press (ENTER) then FCTN 8 for redo. Delete the 90 and press enter and your program will be saved to disk. Press FCTN 8 again and change to DSK2 to save to a second disk. Do 90 FCTN X again and increment the name to PROGO02. By doing this, if the last changes you make to the program created new problems, then you can go back to the previous revision. When your program is done, delete line 90 and save the program. Save the program with a different name using "DSK1.PROGM", MERGE format. Then type NEW, then MERGE "DSK1.PROGM". Then save the program to two disks using the final name.

## DV80APPEND

The Extended BASIC program, DV80APPEND, will append a Display Variable 80 (DV80) format file to the end of an existing DV80 file. One purpose of this utility program is to combine files which are too large for them to both be loaded into the TI-Writer Editor.

Since the TI-Writer Editor uses the last line of the file to store the margin and tab settings, you may wish to load the appended to file using the Editor/Assembler Editor and then save the file back to disk to remove the tab settings line. The only caution using DV80APPEND is that if the first character of a line has an ASCII value greater than 127, then that line will not be included in the output file.

The program works best with the input file on one disk drive and the output file on another disk drive because the disk is accessed for each input and output line.

STAR MICRONICS HAS REDUCED THE PRICE OF THEIR NX1000 RAINBOW PRINTER TO \$199 IN ADS IN COMPUTER SHOPPER. IN ADDITION, THE CPS (CHARACTERS PER SECOND) HAVE BEEN INCREASED TO 225 FROM THE PREVIOUS 144. THIS PRINTER CAN USE BOTH THE 4-COLOR RIBBON AND THE STANDARD RIBBON.



THE STAR XR100 IS STILL SELLING FOR ABOUT \$325 WITH THE COLOR KIT GOING FOR \$45. CITIZEN ALSO ADVERTISES PRINTERS WITH COLOR KITS AT A REASONABLE PRICE. EPSON IS JUST NOW INTRODUCING PRINTERS WITH COLOR KITS

(ALTHOUGH THE PRICE IS HIGHER THAN THE STAR OR CITIZEN BRANDS), AND I AM NOT SURE THAT I HAVE SEEN ANY PANASONICS WITH COLOR KITS.

THUS, IF YOU ARE IN THE MARKET FOR A NEW PRINTER AND CAN AFFORD THE APPROXIMATELY \$50 ADDITIONAL OVER THE STANDARD MODEL, I WOULD HIGHLY RECOMMEND GETTING THE COLOR.

BUT, YOU SAY, WHAT CAN I DO WITH THE COLOR FEATURE AFTER I GET IT? AS ALWAYS, THE HARDWARE HAS TO COME BEFORE THE SOFTWARE AND SEEMS TO BE ALWAYS LAGGING BEHIND. WE DO HAVE SEVERAL PROGRAMS THAT WILL TAKE ADVANTAGE OF COLOR, MOSTLY GRAPHIC PROGRAMS (THAT IS WHERE THE FUN IS ANY WAY). ROGER MERRITT OF COMPRODINE HAS BOTH COLOR CARD AND COLOR FLYER WHICH WILL PRINT YOUR CARDS AND FLYERS IN COLOR. TI-ARTIST PLUS WILL DUMP A COLORED PICTURE.

BUT, THE MOST VERSATILE COLOR PRINTING PROGRAM THAT ALL OF US HAVE IS THE OLD RELIABLE TI-WRITER OR FUNNELWEB AND IT'S TRANSLITERATE FEATURE. YOU CAN ADD COLORED PICTURES TO YOUR LETTERS OR CHANGE A SINGLE WORD TO A DIFFERENT COLOR AND BACK AGAIN IF YOU WISH.

TO REVIEW THE TRANSLITERATE COMMAND, IT ALLOWS YOU TO CHANGE ANY CHARACTER ON THE KEYBOARD TO ANOTHER BY A COMMAND SIMILAR TO:

#### .TL 60:40,40,67,41,41,6

68 IS THE ASCII NUMBER FOR THE LEFT ARROW "(" (YOU FIND THE ASCII CHARACTER NUMBERS IN YOUR PRINTER MANUAL). THUS, IF I INSERTED AN ( IN A SENTENCE, ALL THE REMAINING RORDS (EVERYTHING YOU SEE HERE), WOULD BE PRINTED IN GREEN

UNTIL I CANCELLED THE COMMAND. ANOTHER TRANSLITERATE COMMAND SIMILAR TO:

.TL 62:40,40,67,41,41,0

WOULD RETURN THE PRINTING TO BLACK. THE COLOR COMMAND IS THE SAME UNTIL THE LAST NUMBER. THUS, TO INITIALIZE, YOU NEED THE 48,48,67,41,41. THE LAST NUMBER, WHICH IS 8 THROUGH 6, STANDS FOR: BLACK (8), RED(1), BLUE (2), VIOLET (3), YELLON (4), ORANGE (5), AND GREEN (6).

THIS ENTIRE PAGE HAS BEEN PRINTED THROUGH FUNNELWEB, GRAPHICS AND ALL. HAD I BEEN ABLE TO PRINT IT IN COLOR, THE GRAPHICS AT THE LEFT AT THE TOP WOULD BE GREEN; DMS, ETC. WOULD BE RED, AND AQUARIUS WOULD BE BLUE. ALSO, AT ANY POINT THAT I HAVE REFERRED TO A SPECIFIC COLOR WITHIN THE TEXT, IT WOULD HAVE BEEN PRINTED IN THAT COLOR.

I WILL TRY TO TAKE YOU THROUGH THIS STEP-BY-STEP. IT TAKES SOME TIME, AND I HOPE YOU WILL NOT GET DISCOURAGED, AS THE MORE YOU DO IT, THE MORE ROUTINE IT GETS AND IS NOT THAT DIFFICULT. BEFORE WE START, I WOULD LIKE TO MENTION THAT I HAVE SEVERAL SO-CALLED DESKTOP PUBLISHING PROGRAMS FOR MY IBM COMPATIBLE, AND I DO NOT NECESSARILY FIND THEM ANY EASIER IN THEIR OWN WAY THAN THIS. I FIND I HAVE TO PRINT OUT JUST AS MANY DRAFT COPIES AND GO THROUGH JUST AS MANY REVISIONS AS I HAVE DONE ON MY II.

IN ORDER TO DUPLICATE THIS PAGE, YOU WILL NEED ONE OF THE NEWER PRINTERS THAT WILL PERFORM A "REVERSE FEED TO TOP OF FORM". YOU WILL ALSO NEED ONE OF THE SEVERAL PROGRAMS AVAILABLEE TO TRANSFORM TI-ARTIST INSTANCES TO TI-WRITER FORMAT. WE HAVE IN OUR LIBRARY THE ONE WRITTEN BY ANN DHEIN SEVERAL YEARS AGO. ALSO ON THIS DISK IS AN EXCELLENT TUTORIAL IN USING GRAPHICS WITH TI-WRITER. THERE WAS A TI-ARTIST COMPANION DISK PUT OUT BY TRIO+ SOFTWARE (WHICH I AM NOT SURE IS STILL AVAILABLE) WHICH WAS AN ENHANCED VERSION OF THE DHEIN PROGRAM AND ALSO DID ONE-CHARACTER HIGH ARTIST FONTS FOR USE IN TI-WRITER. THE ONE THAT I USED FOR THE ABOVE EXAMPLES CAME FROM THE PICTURE-IT DISK (\$18) BY RODGER MERRITT.

RODGER'S PROGRAM ALLOWS YOU TO SELECT DOUBLE DENSITY PRINTING WHICH GIVES A MUCH SHARPER PICTURE. EACH OF THE GRAPHICS AT THE TOP OF THE PAGE TOOK ABOUT 20 MINUTES EACH TO CONVERT. THE LARGER THE GRAPHIC, THE LONGER IT TAKES. IF YOU WANT TO DO SOME SPECIAL LETTERHEADS OR HEADINGS, YOU SHOULD GET THEM READY AHEAD OF TIME AND CHOOSE ITEMS YOU WOULD LIKE TO USE OVER AND OVER. BECAUSE THE ABOVE ARE TWO SEPARATE CONVERSIONS, I COULD DO ANOTHER FOR THE LEFT GRAPHIC DEPENDING ON THE SEASON, AND KEEP THE RIGHT GRAPHIC FOR YEAR AROUND USE, ONLY CHANGING THE COLOR, IF DESIRED.

AFTER I CONVERTED THE TWO GRAPHICS, I COMBINED THEM INTO ONE FILE AND SENT A REVERSE LINEFEED TO TOP OF PAGE AT THE END OF THE LEFT GRAPHIC. I HAD CALCULATED HOW MANY SPACES DOWN I WOULD NEED THE RIGHT GRAPHIC AND THE RIGHT AND LEFT MARGINS I WOULD NEED. AFTER PRINTING THE LEFT SIDE, THE PRINTER REVERSED ITSELF AND LINESPACED DOWN TO PRINT THE RIGHT GRAPHIC. THEN ANOTHER REVERSE LINEFEED TO TOP OF FORM COMMAND WAS SENT.

THIS FILE WAS QUITE LARGE, AND I WOULD NEVER HAVE BEEN ABLE TO USE ANY TEXT BEFORE RUNNING OUT OF MEMORY. THUS, AT THE END OF THIS FILE, I USED AN IF DSK1. HEADER COMMAND THAT TOLD THE FORMATTER TO OPEN AND USE ANOTHER FILE WHICH CONTAINED THE TEXT PORTION.

IN PREPARING TEXT, I TOOK A COUPLE OF EXTRA STEPS TO FACILITATE THE FINAL PRINTING. IN ORDER TO PRINT GRAPHICS, YOU CHANGE THE FORMATTER COMMAND FROM PIO.LF TO PIO.CR. IF YOU JUMP DIRECTLY FROM GRAPHICS TO TEXT AND THE TEXT IS NOT FORMATTED CORRECTLY, EACH LINE WILL OVERWRITE ITSELF. THUS, I PREPARED MY TEXT AND RAN IT THROUGH THE FORMATTER WITH THE "PRINT TO DISK" OPTION (CHANGE THE PIO.LF TO DSK1. FILENAME) FEATURE BEFORE I ADDED MY GRAPHIC FILE FOR THE AQUARIUS FIGURE.

I CALCULATED THE NUMBER OF LINES DOWN I WOULD HAVE TO LINEFEED BEFORE MY FIRST LINE OF TEXT. TO GET THE HEADING TO CENTER (DOUBLE WIDE, DOUBLE HIGH), I USED AN LM B AND RM 40 WHICH IS HALF WHAT I WOULD HAVE USED TO CENTER REGULAR TEXT.

EITHER THOUGH TRANSLITERATE COMMANDS OR THRU CTRL U CODES, YOU CAN SET THE DOUBLE HIGH, DOUBLE WIDE AND THEN CANCEL SAME. NEXT, I RESET MY MARGINS TO LM 0; RM 59 TO FORMAT FOR NEWSPAPER COLUMNS AND ALSO SET THROUGH TRANSLITERATE OR CTRL U CODES THE CONDENSED PRINT COMMAND. WHEN YOU TRANSFER YOUR GRAPHIC FROM ARTIST INSTANCE TO TI-WRITER FORMAT, THE PROGRAM TELLS YOU HOW MANY LINES AND HOW MANY COLUMNS IT IS TRANSLATING. THUS, IF YOU JOT THAT DOWN, YOU KNOW ABOUT HOW MANY ROWS DOWN YOU WILL HAVE TO LINEFEED TO INSERT THE GRAPHIC. YOU HAVE TO REMEMBER THAT GRAPHICS RUN 8 LINES PER INCH COMPARED TO THE 6 LINES PER INCH FOR TEXT. THAT IS WHY YOU CANNOT PRINT THEM SIDE-BY-SIDE AT THE SAME TIME.

MY TEXT WAS TYPED, RUN THORUGH THE FORMATTER, AND THE NEW FILE LOADED INTO TI-WRITER. I KNEW APPROXIMATELY HOW MANY LINES I WANTED ON A ROW, AND AT ROW 55 I INSERTED ANOTHER REVERSE FEED TO TOP OF FORM. IT SPACED DOWN THE DESIGNATED LINEFEEDS AND PRINTED THE AQUARIUS FIGURE. AGAIN, I REVERSED TO TOP OF FORM, SPACED DOWN A SPECIFIED NUMBER OF LINEFEEDS, INSTRUCTED THE PRINTER TO SHIFT TO THE RIGHT AND PRINTED THAT TEXT.

MOST OF THE NEWER PRINTERS SPORT A VARIETY OF FONTS WHICH CAN ALSO BE INTERCHANGED THROUGHOUT THE PAGE FOR ADDED INTEREST.

BELIEVE ME, IF YOU START A PROJECT LIKE THIS, YOU LEARN SOME TRICKS. THIS IS AN ARTICLE I HAVE BEEN WANTING TO WRITE FOR A LONG TIME, BUT WASN'T SURE IT WOULD WORK OR HOW TO DO IT. GRAB YOUR II-WRITER MANUAL, GET THE DISK FROM THE

LIBRARY ON USING CRAPHICS WITH TI-WRITER AND SEE WHAT YOU

CAN CREATE!
ON THE FIRST PAGE OF THIS ARTICLE, I TOTALLY FORGOT TO
INCLUDE TIPS AS ONE OF THE PROGRAMS WHICH USES THE COLOR
PRINTER. AND VERY WELL AT THAT. IF YOU THINK YOU WOULD HAVE
MORE PROGRAMS FOR COLOR PRINTERS IF YOU HAD AN IBM
COMPATIBLE, THINK AGAIN. I ONLY HAVE TWO PROGRAMS OVER
THERE FOR COLOR. ONE IS THE NEW PRINTSHOP AND YOUR CHOICES
ARE VERY LIMITED. I MUCH PREFER TIPS. THE OTHER IS WORD
PERFECT 5.1. SETTING UP A PAGE IN WORD PERFECT 5.1 IS NOT
DISSINILAR TO DOING IT WITH TI-WRITER. HAD I HAD THE TIME,
I WOULD HAVE LIKED TO HAVE DONE THE SAME PAGE WITH BOTH
PROGRAMS. PERHAPS ANOTHER MONTH, I WILL DO A PAGE WITH WORD
PERFECT AND SHOW YOU THAT TI-WRITER CAN DO THE SAME.

## PREPARING YOUR TAXES WITH MULTIPLAN DEANNA SHERIDAN - NORTHCOAST 99ERS

AS NOTED BY STEVE BAGSTAD, I WILL BE GIVING THE DEMO AT THE NEXT NORTHCOAST MEETING ABOUT DOING YOUR INCOME TAXES WITH MULTIPLAN. I WOULD LIKE TO GIVE YOU A LITTLE BACKGROUND ON HOW THIS IS DONE, SO YOU WILL HAVE AN IDEA OF WHAT IS GOING ON AT THE NEETING.

YOU MAY OR MAY NOT KNOW THAT THE IRS ALLOWS YOU TO FILE "APPROVED" SUBSTITUTE FORMS INSTEAD OF USING THE PREPRINTED ONES THAT YOU RECEIVE IN THE MAIL EACH YEAR. NEARLY ALL PROFESSIONAL TAXPAYERS USE SUCH FORMS, AND YOU CAN ALSO. YOU CAN USE A COPY OF AN APPROVED FORM FROM A BOOK, OR YOU CAN ACTUALLY SEND IN A COPY OF THE FORM YOU WOULD LIKE TO USE TO THE IRS AND GET APPROVAL. THERE IS AN IRS DOCUMENT WHICH OUTLINES ALL OF THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THESE FORMS WHICH WOULD BE READ BY ANY ONE DESIRING TO CREATE THEIR OWN SUBSTITUTE FORMS.

THE ONLY FORMS OR SCHEDULES WHICH CANNOT BE SUBMITTED ON THE SUBSTITUE FORMS ARE THOSE WHICH REQUIRE TAXPAYER'S SIGNATURE. THUS, THE 1848 FORM ITSELF WILL HAVE TO BE COPIED OR TYPED ONTO THE ORIGINAL. ALL THE OTHERS CAN BE THE SUBSTITUTE FORMS.

I PICKED UP A BOOK ON DOING BOOKKEEPING AND TAXES WITH LOTUS WHICH ANYONE CAN USE. OF COURSE, THE SAME DESIGN IS POSSIBLE WITH OUR MULTIPLAN.

WE USE A PROGRAM IN MY CPA OFFICE WHICH UTILIZES THE SUBSTITUTE FORMS. I HAVE USED THESE AS A GUIDE FOR CREATING MY FORMS ON MULTIPLAN. I HAVE DONE THE FOLLOWING: FORM 1840, SCHEDULES A, B, C, D, E & SE, FORMS 4562 AND 2441. THUS, I HOPE TO DO A FAIRLY COMPLICATED TAX RETURN WITH MULTIPLAN DOING MOST OF THE WORK FOR ME.

I WILL HAVE DISKS AVAILABLE IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO TRY THIS ON YOUR OWN. THERE WILL BE ALL KINDS OF WARNINGS IN THE DOCUMENTATION THAT I TAKE NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE RESULTS. YOU SHOULD ALWAYS DOUBLE-CHECK YOUR MATH. THIS SHOULD BE FUN, ESPECIALLY SINCE PEOPLE SAY THERE ARE NO TAX PROGRAMS FOR THE TI!

I SHOULD MENTION THAT A MR. BILL CHAVANNE OF 4549 ENGLISH AVENUE, FT. MEADE, MD 20755 (301)672-1988 HAS DONE A TAX PROGRAM ON MULTIPLAN FOR SEVERAL YEARS. I BELIEVE HE CHARGES SOMETHING LIKE \$28 FOR FORM 1040 AND THEN AN ADDITIONAL CHARGE FOR EACH SCHEDULE YOU NEED. IF YOU FEEL

YOU NEED A MORE "PROFESSIONAL" VERSION, YOU SHOULD CONTACT HIM.

BY THE WAY, IF YOU TAKE ON A PROJECT LIKE THIS, YOU SURE LEARN HOW TO USE A PROGRAM. I WAS, AND STILL AM, A MOVICE IN MULTIPLAN, BUT I CAN GET AROUND IT MUCH EASIER THAN BEFORE. ALSO, BECAUSE OF THE XTERNAL COPY COMMAND, YOU CAN LINK SEVERAL FILES AND YOU CAN ALSO CREATE A COMPLETE GENERAL LEDGER SYSTEM ON MULTIPLAN FOR A SMALL BUSINESS. PERHAPS IF I GET THE TIME, I WILL TRY TO DO A TEMPLATE FOR THAT LATER ON.

## GENIE CONFERENCE WITH IRWIN HOTT OF COLUMBUS REGARDING SPEECH AND TI CLEARING HOUSE

AS I DID WITH THE CONFERENCE WITH CHRIS BOBBITT, I AM SUMMARIZING THIS CONFERENCE AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE AND UPLOADING THE ENTIRE FILE TO THE FREENET IF YOU DESIRE TO READ IT IN IT'S ENTIRETY.

IRVIN HOTT: WE ARE HOPING TO START A "CLEARINGHOUSE" BBS THAT WOULD MAKE IT POSSIBLE TO EXCHANGE ORIGINAL NEWSLETTER ARTICLES. THE IDEA CAME ABOUT AFTER A MEETING OF OFFICERS AT THE LIMA TI FAIR. WE HAVE HAD A CONSIDERABLE AMOUNT OF DISCUSSION SINCE, AND HOPE TO GET THINGS GOING IF WE GET ENOUGH SUPPORT SOMETIME EARLY IN 1991?

QUESTION: HAS ANYONE SET A PRICE YET?

IRVIN HOTT: WE ARE LOOKING AT UPGRADING THE CURRENT CENTRAL OHIO NINETY-NINER'S BBS TO ADD A HARD DRIVE, CONTROLLER, ETC. WE ARE ASKING \$30 PER USER GROUP FOR THE YEAR. WE ESTIMATE THAT WOULD COVER THE COSTS IF WE GET 25 GROUPS.

QUESTION BY GARY COX: WHAT WOULD THE \$30 GO FOR? ACCESS TO THE BBS FOR THE ARTICLES?

IRWIN HOTT: SO FAR WE HAVE ABOUT \$400 OR SO. GARY, THAT WOULD GIVE ACCESS TO SAY 7 MEMBERS OF THE UG TO DOWNLOAD ANY ORIGINAL ARTICLES ON THE BBS. THAT WOULD ALLOW US TO START UP AND RUN FOR THE FIRST YEAR. WE HAVE PROMISED TO RETURN ANY MONEY IF WE DO NOT GET ENOUGH BY FEBRUARY 1, 1991. ONE OF THE MAJOR CONCERNS FROM GROUPS HAS BEEN THE COST OF DOUMLOAD TIME.

QUESTION BY GARY COX: THAT WAS MY CONCERN...LONG DISTANCE CHARGES. WHAT BAUD RATE WOULD THE BBS BE?

IRVIN HOTT: I AM NOT SURE HOW MUCH CAN BE DONE TO REDUCE THOSE CHARGES. WE ARE ACCESSIBLE THROUGH STARLINK. WE MOULD BE AT 2400, AND I WOULD EXPECT THAT ALL FILES WOULD BE ARCHIVED. WE MIGHT BE ABLE TO WORK SOMETHING OUT AS TO MAILING DOWNLOADS. WE WOULD HAVE TO LOOK AT HOW MUCH TIME IT WOULD TAKE.

BARRY TRAVER: I'M NOT FAIMILIAR WITH STARLINK. IS IT AN ALTERNATIVE TO PC PURSUIT?

IRWIN HOTT: I HAVE ALREADY FIGURED THAT UPLOADS COULD BE SENT ON DISK TO KEEP DOWN THE COST. YES, STARLINK IS, I THINK, ABOUT \$1 PER HOUR AND REACHES MANY MORE CITIES THAN PCP. ONE OF THE REASONS FOR GOING TO THE BBS RATHER THAN MAIL IS TO MAKE THE MATERIAL AVAILABLE A LITTLE MORE OUICKLY.

BARRY TRAVER: IF STARLINK IS BETTER, IT MIGHT BE GOOD TO GET THAT INFORMATION OUT TO PEOPLE WHO DON'T KNOW ABOUT IT.

GARY COX: IS THERE ANY MINIMUM CHARGE PER MONTH ON STARLINK AMO/OR OTHER RESTRICTIONS?

IRVIN NOTT: I AM STILL USING PCP AS THEIR HANDICAPPED RATE IS STILL PRETTY 6000. \$30 FOR 90 HOURS. I THINK STARLINK IS ABOUT \$10 PER MONTH MINIMUM. IT HAS BEEN A WHILE SINCE I HAVE SEEN THEIR INFO THOUGH. WE HAVE TALKED ABOUT THE IDEA OF DISTRIBUTING THE NEW FILES BY MAIL, BUT I AM NOT SURE THE TIME IT WOULD TAKE IS WORTH IT. I CAN SEE COPYING LOTS OF DISKS EACH MONTH.

GARY COX: STILL, A BBS FOR A CLEARING HOUSE ON ARTICLES IS BETTER THAN NOTHING AT ALL. WHAT IS THE BBS GOING TO RUN ON (TI OR GENEVE), AS I WAS THINKING ABOUT BAUD RATES ABOVE 2400 AS I CAN HANDLE 192,000 BAUD DOWNLOADING THROUGH MY PC TO GET AS MUCH AS I CAN WHILE ON LONG DISTANCE. EVEN AN MPM 5 MODEM WOULD GIVE BAUD RATES UP TO 4800.

IRWIN HOTT: WE ARE PLANNING TO RUN ON A TI FOR NOW, BUD WRIGHT HAS SAID WE COULD USE HIS SOFTWARE AND THAT WOULD SPEED THE SYSTEM UP SOME TOO.

GARY COX: WOULD THE BBS BE ACCESSIBLE ONLY BY THOSE WHO PAID FOR ACCESS?

IRWIN HOTT: THE ORIGINAL MATERIAL WOULD ONLY BE ACCESSIBLE TO THOSE TO HAD PAID FOR IT. THERE WOULD BE OTHER SECTIONS AVAILABLE TO EVERYONE. WE HAVE HAD A COUPLE OF OFFERS TO SET THE CLEARINGHOUSE UP ON EXISTING BBS' IF WE CANNOT GET IT GOING HERE.

JEFF WHITE: WOULD AUTHORS OR USER GROUPS THAT PROVIDE THE ARTICLES HAVE SPECIAL PRIVILEGES?

IRNIN HOTT: THAT HAS NOT BEEN DETERMINED, BUT IT WOULD SEEM REASONABLE. IF WE CAN GET PEOPLE TO SUBMIT ARTICLES OR CAPTURE OR DOWNLOAD FROM SOMEWHERE ELSE, I THINK THAT COULD BE A BIG PART OF THE SYSTEM. I KNOW I SOMETIMES HAVE TAKEN MESSAGE THREADS FROM BBS', EDITED AND PUT THEM ON THE BBS HERE OR IN FILE FORMAT SO THEY COULD BE DOWNLOADED OR CAPTURED. ONE OF THE PROBLEMS NOW IS THAT WHEN AN ARTICLE IS PUBLISHED IN A NEWSLETTER, IT MAY TAKE 4 OR 5 MONTHS BEFORE IT GETS AROUND TO OTHER NEWSLETTERS. WE ARE HOPING THAT WE COULD CUT DOWN ON THE LEAD TIME CONSIDERABLY.

BARRY TRAYER: ABOUT HOW MANY GROUPS HAVE SIGNED UP SO FAR (OR HAVE EXPRESSED INTENTION TO DO SO)?

IRWIN HOTT: TO ANSWER YOUR QUESTION ABOUT SUPPORT, WE HAVE FINANCIAL SUPPORT FROM ABOUT 5 USER GROUPS PLUS TIGERCUB SOFTWARE. WE HAVE ABOUT 3 OTHER GROUPS WHO HAVE EXPRESSED AN INTEREST. WE HAD SET AN AMOUNT OF \$30 FOR THE FIRST YEAR (ASSUMING 25 GROUPS) AND HAD FIGURED MAYBE \$15 OR SO A YEAR AFTER THAT.

CED NOTE: THE ABOVE WAS DISCUSSED AT THE LIMA FAIRE LAST SPRING. WE HAVE RECEIVED A GENERAL NOTICE OF WHAT THE COLUMBUS CLUB IS TRYING TO ACHIEVE. WHILE THE CONCEPT IS NICE, I HAVE SOME OF THE SAME RESERVATIONS AS EXPRESSED HEREIN, IE, UPLOAD AND DOWNLOAD TIME. I FIGURE I WOULD HAVE TO GO IN AND UPLOAD ALL OF MY TI-WRITER FILES WHEN I FINISHED THE MONTHLY NEWSLETTER AND THEN WOULD HAVE TO CHECK

IN ONCE OR TWICE A MONTH FOR POSSIBLE DOWNLOADS TO USE IN OUR NEWSLETTER. AM ASSUMING THIS WOULD INCUR CLOSE TO AN HOUR OF LONG DISTANCE CALLS PER MONTH. AM NOT SURE OF THE COST THE CLUB WOULD INCUR EACH MONTH IN ADDITION TO THE \$30 FEE. WE ARE OF THE FORTUNATE FEW THAT HAS A LOT OF ORIGINAL MATERIAL EACH MONTH AND OUR TIME AND EFFORTS WOULD BE MORE BENEFICIAL TO THOSE AT THE OTHER END THAN TO US. I RAN THIS BY THE NORTHCOAST PEOPLE RECENTLY AND DID NOT GET TOO MUCH RESPONSE. I BARELY HAVE TIME TO DEVOTE TO GET OUR NEWSLETTER OUT; DON'T EVEN GET THINGS POSTED ON FREENET I HAVE, LET ALONE COLUMBUS. WOULD BE GLAD TO DISCUSS THIS MORE WITH ANYONE WHO MIGHT HAVE THE DESIRE TO BE OUR DESIGNATED UPLOADER AND DOWNLOADER TO THE COLUMBUS BOARD SHOULD BE JOIN.) DEANNA.

JEFF WHITE: IRWIN, IF I RECALL YOU FROM A PREVIOUS CHICAGO FAIRE, YOU ARE BLIND. OR WAS THAT SOMEONE ELSE?

IRMIN HOTT: RIGHT. I AM BLIND AND AM USING A COUPLE OF DIFFERENT SPEECH SYNTHESIZERS.

BARRY TRAVER: JUDGING FROM YOUR PERFORMANCE THIS EVENING, I THINK YOU AND JIM PETERSON WOULD BE AN IDEAL COMBINATION. HE CLAIMS THAT HE CAN'T TYPE FAST ENOUGH)...BUT, IRWIN, YOU CERTAINLY SEEM TO HAVE THAT SKILL MASTERED!

IRWIN HOTT: BECAUSE I TYPE AWAY AND SOMEONE ELSE'S WORDS COME OUT OF THE SPEECH SYNTHESIZER. I GET SPOILED BY THE LIMA NEWSLETTER BECAUSE I CAN DUMP IT TO DISK AND READ IT. I AM USING FAST-TERM AND DUMPING TO SPEECH OUT THE RS232/2 PORT. I AM USING A SYNTHESIZER FROM B. G. MICRO. IT IS ABOUT A \$69 SYNTHESIZER AND IS NOT VERY CONTROLLABLEVAS TO SPEED, ECT. IF I NEED SPEED, I DUMP TO MY BRAILLE 'N SPEAK WHICH HAS ABOUT 200K OF MEMORY AND A SPEECH SYNTHESIZER. THAT IS WHAT I USE TO WRITE ARTICLES, EDIT TI PROGRAMS, ETC. ONCE IN A LONG WHILE I USE TE II AND SOMETIMES I USE TEXT-TO-SPEECH, BUT MOST OF THE TIME I USE THE EXTERNAL SPEECH SYNTHESIZER. I CAN GET CATALOGS FROM ARCHIVER AND DM1800, AND I CAN—USE DSKU FAIRLY WELL THANKS TO A MODIFICATION BY JOHN BIRDWELL.

JEFF WHITE: MAYBE GARY BOWSER'S SPEECH PROJECT WILL BE OF USE TO YOU. I DON'T KNOW MUCH ABOUT IT, BUT FROM WHAT HE SAYS, IT REALLY MAKES THE TI SYNTHESIZER SOUND GREAT.

IRVIN HOTT: I can't wait to see it. I went to Chicago with money in my pocket to get the Dicks, but it was not ready. Actually, the module expander might be of more use...

JEFF WHITE: I KNOW I WOULD LIKE TO HAVE MORE PROGRAMS THAT USE SPEECH.

IRWIN HOTT: THAT WOULD ALLOW ACCESS TO TEIL SPEECH IN XB. THAT WOULD MAKE IT EASY TO ADD SPEECH TO LONG PROGRAMS. I AM NOT ONE TO GET EXCITED ABOUT THE QUALITY OF SPEECH. THE TI SPEECH SOUNDS PRETTY GOOD ALREADY...

BARRY TRAVER: IRWIN, WHAT WOULD BE THE ADVANTAGE OF THAT OVER TEXT-TO-SPEECH?

IRWIN HOTT: I WANT SPEED AND FLELXIBILITY MORE. TEXT-TO-SPEECH YOU ARE LIMITED TO ABOUT A 49 SECTOR PROGRAM. THE DATABASE FILE TAKES UP SO MUCH ROOM IN HIGH MEMORY. THAT MIGHT ALSO GIVE YOU ACCESS TO FULL SPEECH IN ASSEMBLY OR IN JUST ABOUT WHATEVER LANGUAGE YOU ARE RUNNING. I WOULD HAVE LOVED TO HAVE BEEN ABLE TO USE THE TI SPEECH IN MY BBS PROGRAM, FOR EXAMPLE. I USED THE EXTERNAL WHENEVER I WANT THE PROGRAM TO SPEAK, I JUST PRINT TO IT. I HAVE ABOUT 3 DISKS THAT I SEND OUT TO BLIND PEOPLE WHO NEED PROGRAMS, ETC. THAT USE SPEECH. I AM WORKING ON BETTER DOCS FOR THEM AND WHEN I GET THOSE DONE FAIRLY WELL, I WILL UPLOAD THE FILES TO GENIE. I UPLOADED A FILE OF SPEECH STUFF A COUPLE OF YEARS AGO, BUT IT IS SOMEWHAT OUT OF DATE. I WILL FREELY ADMIT THAT THE SPEECH ON A PC WITH THE PROPER SOFTWARE AND HARDWARE IS MORE FLEXIBLE. BUT YOU ARE TALKING ABOUT \$500 FOR HARDWARE AND \$200 TO \$1000 FOR A SPEECH SYNTHESIZER.

JEFF WHITE: GARY BOWER'S PROJECT SHOULD MAKE IT EASIER FOR PROGRAMMERS TO USE SPEECH, I HOPE. THE WAY TI RECOMMENDED IT TO BE DONE WAS QUITE CUMBERSOME. HE SAYS HE HAS FOUND A BETTER WAY.

IRWIN HOTT. I THINK SO. IT IS A COMBINATION OF UTILITIES FOR BLIND PEOPLE AND SPEECH THAT HAS BEEN AROUND FOR A WHILE.

BARRY TRAVER: I'VE ALWAYS BEEN CURIOUS ABOUT THE "FLIP-TOP" ON THE SPEECH SYNTHESIZER. I'VE WONDERED EXACTLY WHAT TI'S PLANS FOR FUTURE EXPANSION WOULD HAVE BEEN.

IRWIN ROTT: AS I THOURSTAND IT IT WAS INTENDED TO ADD A MODULE SO THAT YOU COULD INCREASE THE VOCABULARY.

BARRY TRAVER: BUT YOU HAVE UNLIMITED SPEECH WITH TEXT-TO-SPECCH AND TEZ, SO THAT WOULD HAVE BEEN ONLY FOR X8?

IRWIN HOTT: I THINK IT WOULD HAVE BEEN FOR CALL SAY. ONE OF THE THINGS YOU CAN DO, IS TAKE THE WORDS IN THE SPEAK & SPELL PROGRAM THAT II SOLD SEVERAL YEARS AGO AND USE THEM IN OTHER PROGRAMS. SORT OF LIKE THE CALL SAY UTILITY THAT WAS ON GT. I MADE A LIST OF ALL OF THOSE WORDS ONCE AND THE RECORD NUMBERS IN THE RELATIVE FILE. I PLAYED AROUND WITH USING THEM IN OTHER PROGRAMS, AND FOUND THAT FAIRLY EASY TO DO.

BARRY TRAVER: It would be nice, though, to be able to grab the speech data from Parsec and some of the other modules.

AT THIS POINT BARRY THANKED IRWIN FOR BEING GENIE'S ROUNDTABLE GUEST AND THEY CLOSED OFF. REMEMBER, THE ENTIRE TEXT WILL BE ON THE FREENET.

INSERTING RETURNS TO DEFAULTS, WHILE SIMPLY ENTERING AT THE BOTTOM KEEPS JUSTIFICATIONS INTACT. WE'LL CLEAN THIS UP IN A MOMENT. COPY THE CALCULATIONS FOR KWH/D AND C/KWH DOWN INTO THE NEW ROWS. WE'RE ALMOST DONE FOR THIS TIME.
