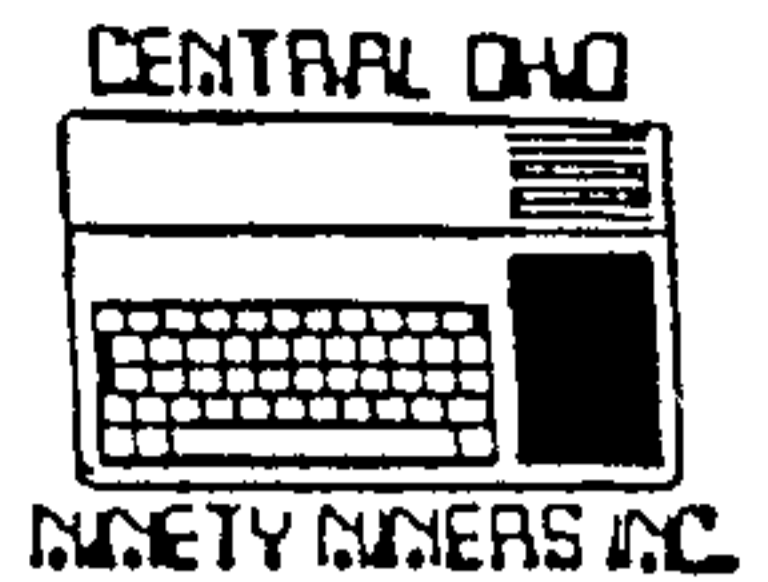


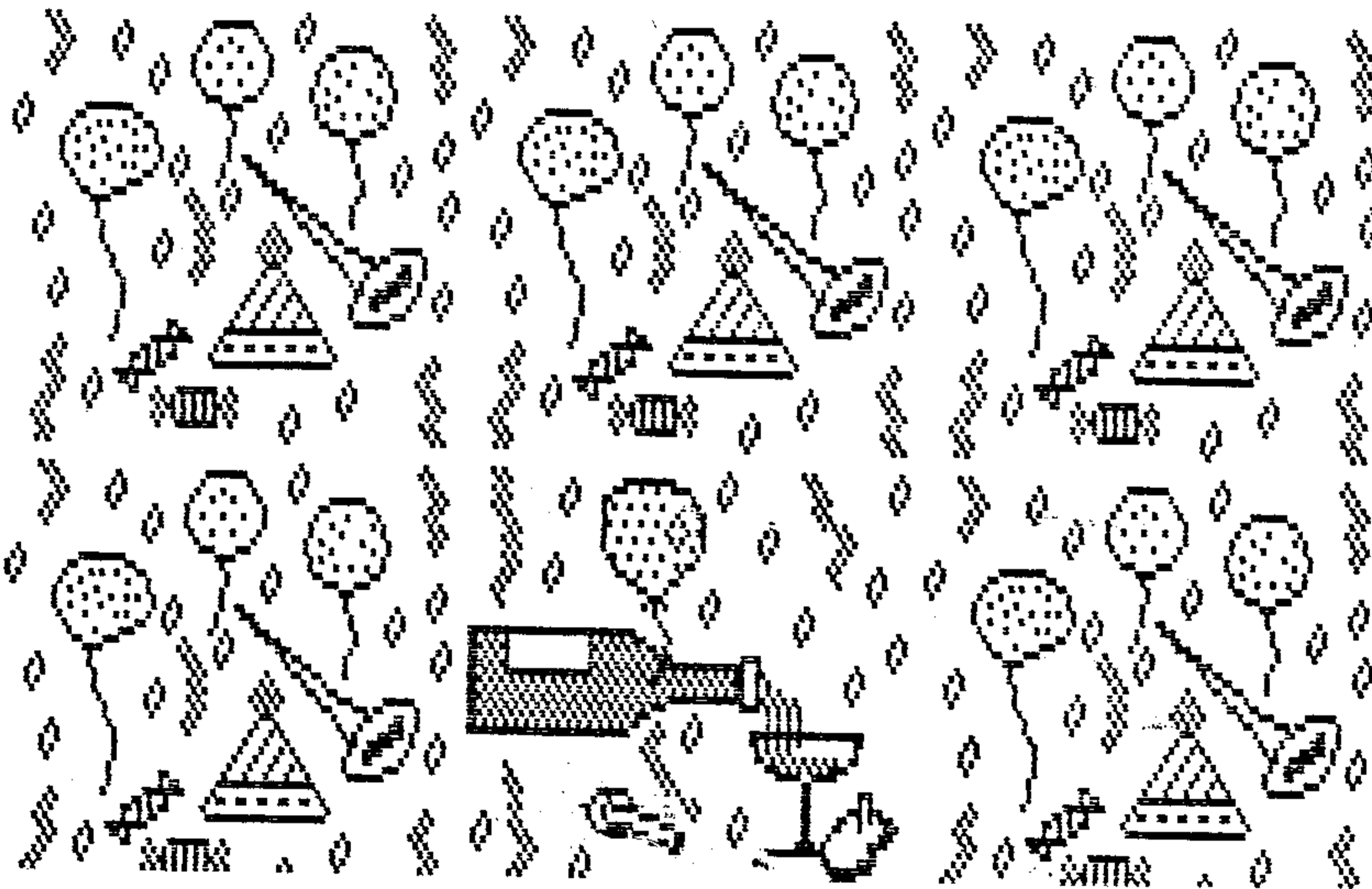

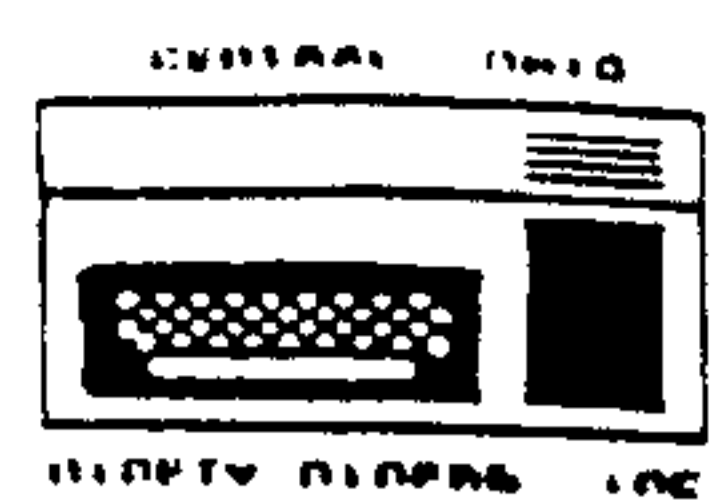

CLEARINGHOUSE BBS IDEA

This brief article will bring you up to date on the Clearinghouse BBS idea. For more on what the Clearinghouse is, see file HOTT CO which is the transcript of the GENIE conference which was held on 10 Dec 1990. The file may be found on library 5 of the SPIRIT of 99 TIBBS.

Much of the discussion revolving around the Clearinghouse has been about the cost of downloading. Recently PC-Pursuit announced that Columbus, OH was being added as an "out-dial" city. This means that if you subscribe to PC-Pursuit you may call us for \$1.00 per hour, up to 30 hours a month. For more information on PC-Pursuit, call 800-736-1130. For those of you who are current PC-Pursuit customers use "OHCOL" to reach us. All 3 Columbus TI BBS's are reachable through PC-Pursuit.

We are still estimating a cost of \$30 per user group for the Clearinghouse. February 1st is the deadline for receiving enough money to get the Clearinghouse started. As of late December we had received approximately \$500.
