Have you ever wished that you could tell the difference between the alpha character "0" and the numeric "0", or the alpha "1" and the numeric "1" while editing a program in Extended Basic. I've seen this program a number of times in the last couple of years, but always forgot to include it in our newsletter. Well here it is. You must have 32K memory exp. and Extended basic for this to run. Enter the following program and run it:

```
100 CALL INIT :: CALL LOAD(16128,2,224,38,0,2,0,8,17,2,1,63,36,2,2,0,3,
    4,32,32,36,2,224,131,192,3,128):: CALL LOAD(16164,240,240,240)
```

(Before you run it save it to cassette or disk for further use)

To turn this feature ON type in command mode (no line numbers), CALL LOAD(-31804,63) and when you wish to turn it OFF, CALL LOAD(-31804,0).

This will turn ALL NUMBERS and some symbols to WHITE and then you will be able to easily identify an "0" from a "0" or an "1" from a "1".
