From the Editor...


The West Penn 99'ers wish to extend their sympathy to Ray Bronder, whose wife recently passed away. May our prayers be with you at this difficult time.

The FRONT RANGER OF DEC. 91 has a TI-RS232 fixed by Jack Mathis Because of the small print, I am coping the artical. Any mastakes can be my typing or spelling. I recomend that you look at the FRONT RANGER or contact Jack.

I'll do my best to copy the best I can.

I recently had a TI RS232 card go bad. The RS232 operations functioned normally, but the PIO would not output. On the II the light would come on and stay on. On the Geneve, the light would flicker very fast, but still wouldn't print. I found the 7415259 (VI2) controlled the strobe line for the PIO port. I also found CRV 1300 addresses the 74L5259.

Bit 0 - turns on the card

Bit 4 - to 74L5259

1 - PIO sends data 2 - controls PIO strobe

5 - MS232 pin 5 6 - RS232 pin 13

3 - spare out pin 14 on PIO

7 - LED

If the light is able to come on, all address lines to the chip is working.

I further discovered the 74L5251 (UI3) is for test bit functions.

Bit 0 - always off

Bit 4 - from 74L52S9

1 - PIO sends data

5 - RS232 pin 5

2 - PIO acknowledge


6 - RS232 pin 13

3 - Spare in pin 13 on P10

7 - LED

Bits 0,1,2 on both chips are needed for the PIO port to work properly. I replaced the 74L5259, tried the card to no aveil. Replaced the 74L5251 tried with same results. Again replaced the 74L5259 and it worked. I belive the bad 74L5251 took out the frist 74L5259. I would recomend replacing both VI2 and VI3 at the same time, should you decide this is your problem.
