





Welcome Back!

The TI CASINO SUPPLEMENT package isn't really an update, though it could be considered so. What it actually is, is several add-on and alternate features for TI CASINO users.

The alternate features consist of 4 new acts for the Comedian at Club Notung. Several of these acts are considerably more "Adult" in content. Secondly, there is an alternate slot machine with slightly altered graphics. The slot machine not only takes silver dollars, up to 5 at a time, but also \$10 and \$25 tokens as well. The machine is a little more difficult, too (I made the original too easy to win in my opinion). Instead of any cherry paying-off, just the final cherry will.

A new game has also been added and room for 7 more (possible future releases). The game is the Old West card game called "FARO" (check the rules in the manual for assistance). This game is a single player version of my "Disk of the Old West" game.

Heard any new jokes?

On this disk, there are 5 files with the prefix, "JOKEFILE". These are replacements for the "JOKEFILE" found on your TI-CASINO disk (or Disk B in the SSSD version). To make alternations, first make a back-up of your TI CASINO disk, then copy

the file "A9" from the Supplemental Disk to the appropriate Casino disk. Then, copy over your newly chosen jokefile to the Casino disk, retitling it "JOKEFILE" (removing the "/", number suffix at the end of the filename). The content of the Jokefiles are as follows:

JOKEFILE/0 - The original TI-Casino Version
JOKEFILE/1 - Mostly clean jokes, rated PG
JOKEFILE/2 - Jokes on particular groups of people, some may be considered offensive, rated PG13
JOKEFILE/3 - Offensive language, rated R
JOKEFILE/4 - Offensive language and explicit jokes, rated X

A New Slot Machine!

To use the alternative SLOT MACHINE, first make a back-up of your TI-CASINO diskette. Then replace files "A7" and "J" on your Casino Disk with the ones on the Supplement Disk.

Adding the Faro game

To add FARO and the UPSTAIRS of the Lobby to your TI CASINO, copy files "A10" and "S" from the Supplement Disk to your TI Casino Disk. Replace files "MENU" and "B" with the ones on the Supplement Disk as well.

The new Lobby...

In order to put the Faro Table in, it was necessary to create an upstairs Lobby. The up/downstairs lobby select area is above the chips and cash total count area. Press fire in this area to go up or downstairs. This area used to be Club Notung. Club Notung is now been relocated upstairs.

FARO

Playing Faro is relatively easily. The player bets amounts on Ace through King. Suits have no value. A single deck of cards is then shuffled and two cards are dealt at a time. The first card dealt loses, the second wins. In the case of a tie, half the amount of the bet is lost. Bets unaffected by the play of the two cards are unchanged, though may be added to or removed from play. At the end of the deck, it is reshuffled, and play resumes.

Playing at TI Casino

To play Faro at TI-Casino, first select PLAY FARO. To bet, select MAKE A WAGER. When your betting is completed, select BETTING COMPLETED.

Once you have decided to MAKE A WAGER, your cursor will appear above the ACE. Move the cursor to the card you wish to bet on and press fire. You will then be asked for a wager amount. Move the joystick to the desired amount and press fire. Faro has a \$100 wager limit. You may bet on as many cards as desired. If you already have a bet on a particular card and you chose it again, you will have the option of either removing the entire amount or adding/subtracting a portion of it.

Once you have completed your betting and selected BETTING COMPLETED, two cards will appear at the right of the screen. The First (top) card loses and all bets on that card are removed. The Second (bottom) card wins. The bet on that card is removed and you are paid 2 to 1. If a tie occurs, the bet is

removed and you are paid half the original wager.

You probably will notice a strange box between the playing board and the menu box. This is an abacus. Most Faro players had them to help keep track of what cards have been played. As cards are played, the beads on the abacus will slide downward.

Helpful Playing Tips

Faro is basically a game of chance with a little skill. Watching the abacus and knowing what cards have been played will help to enhance your chances.
