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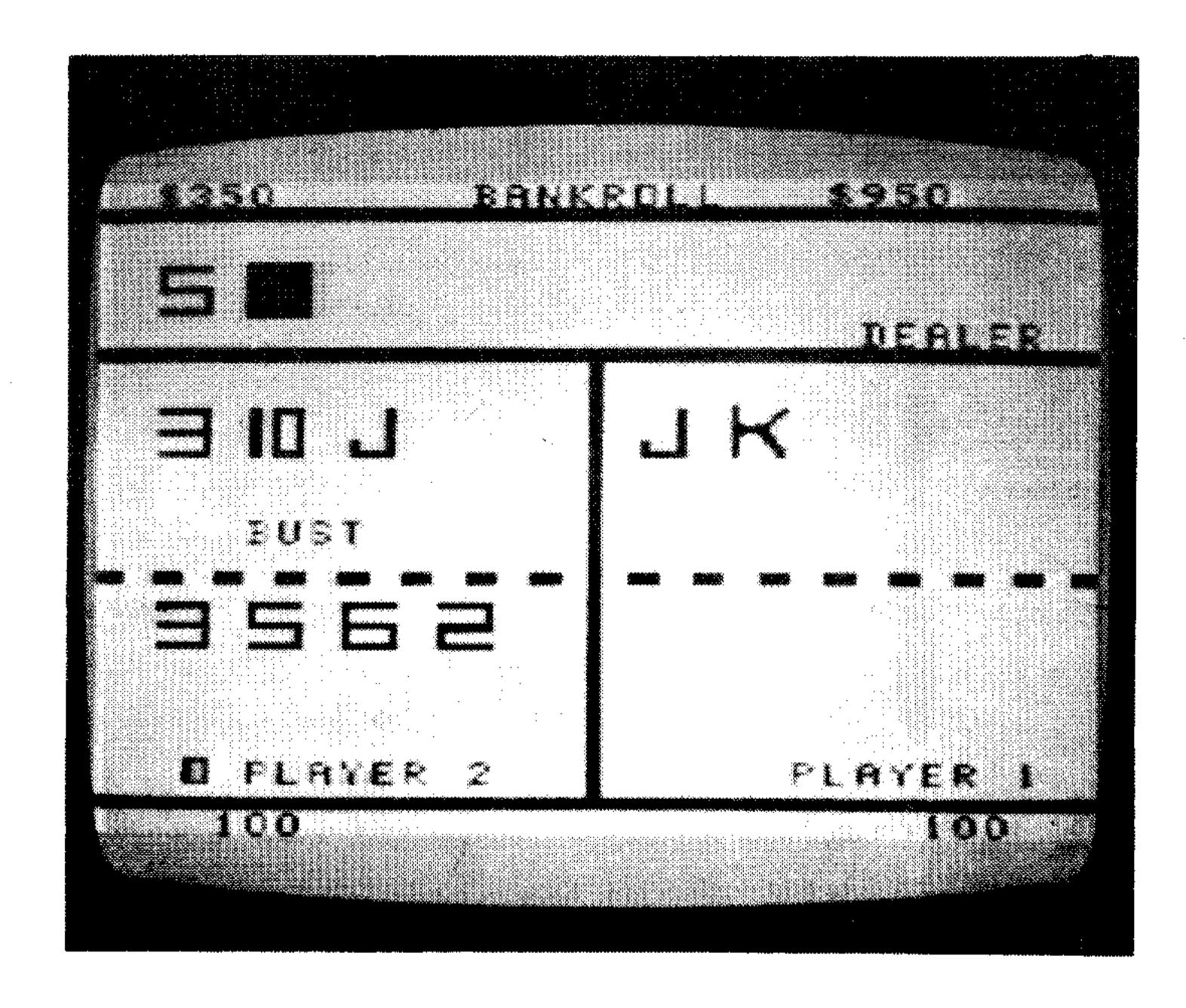

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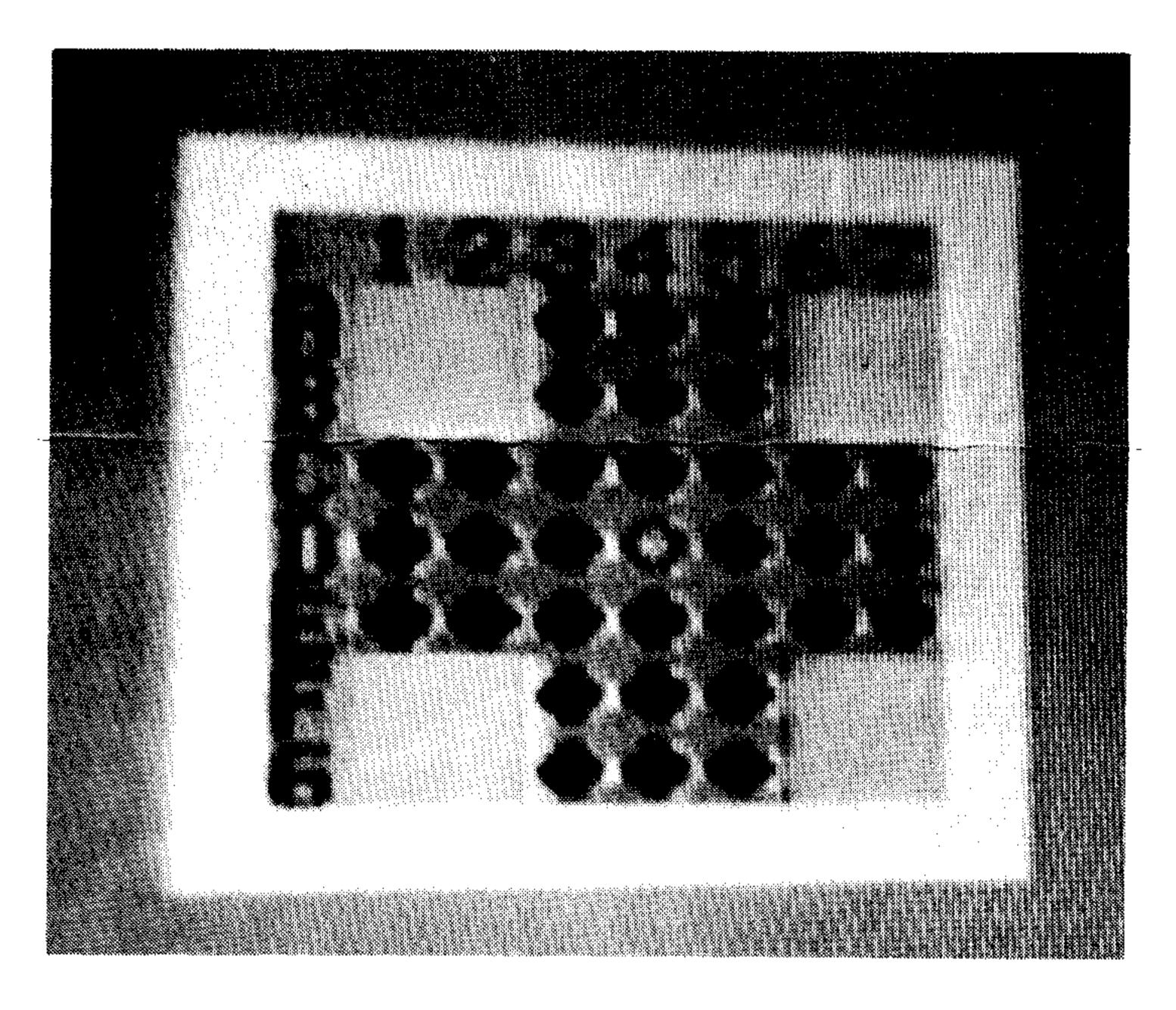
BLACKJACK

Your computer screen comes alive with the thrill of Las Vegas with this exciting Blackjack game for either one or two players. The computer is the dealer and each player is pitted against the odds. Each player bets and the cards are dealt. If a player is dealt two identical cards, he is given the option to double by having his hand split into two hands. If a player gets 5 cards totaling 21 or less he is an automatic winner. This game is available only in extended Basic, but no other computer accessories are required.

PEGBOARD CHALLENGE

You start with 32 pegs in 33 holes in this computer version of the old favorite peg jumping game. Each peg which you jump is removed from the board until no more jumps are possible. The object of the game is to remove as many pegs as you can from the board. Can you get all but the last peg? If you get good enough to have only one peg remaining, can you make it end up in the center hole? The computer displays the score of the last game and the best score of the day. The computer also recognizes when the game is over and automatically starts a new game.

No computer accessories are required for this game.

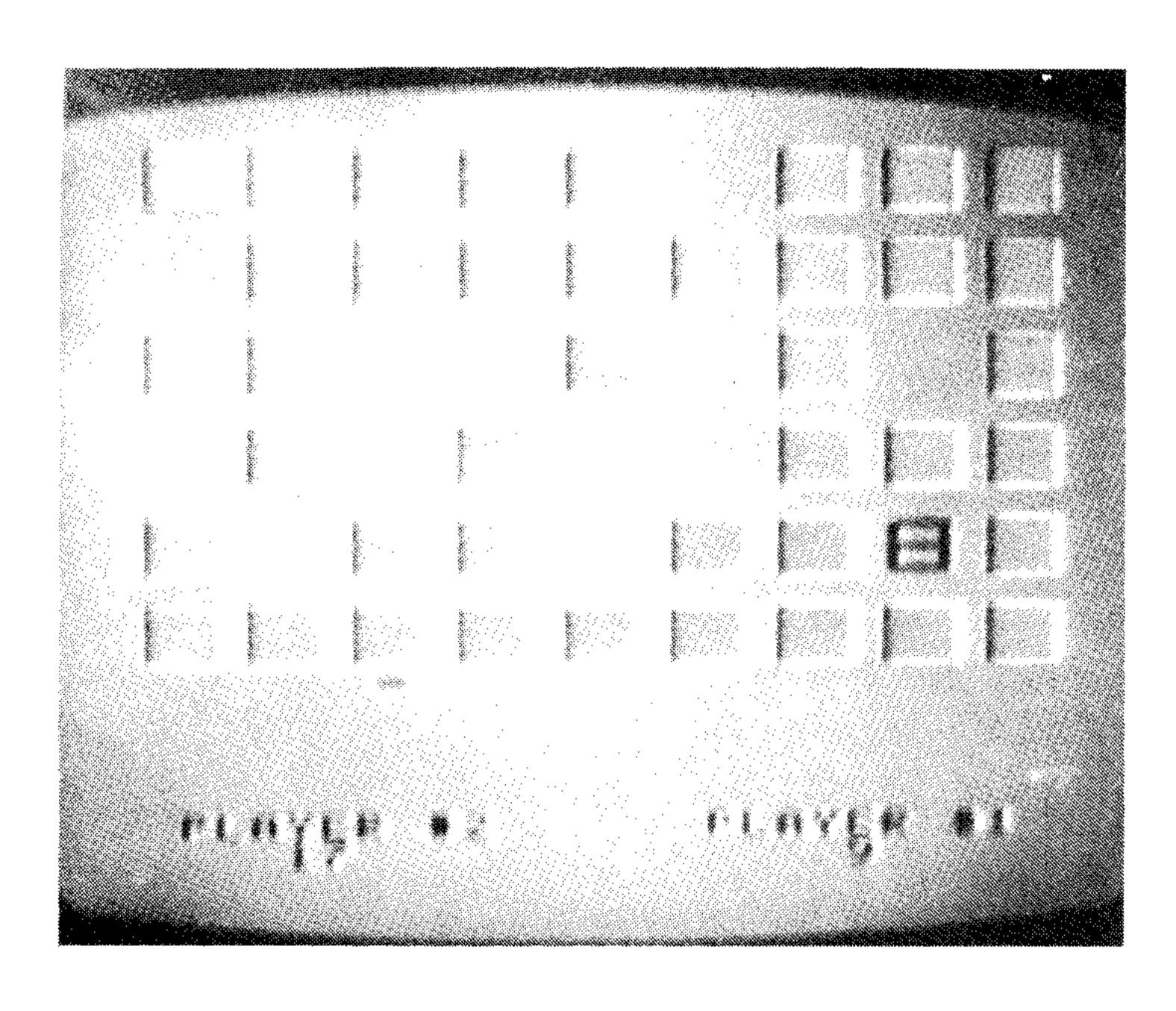


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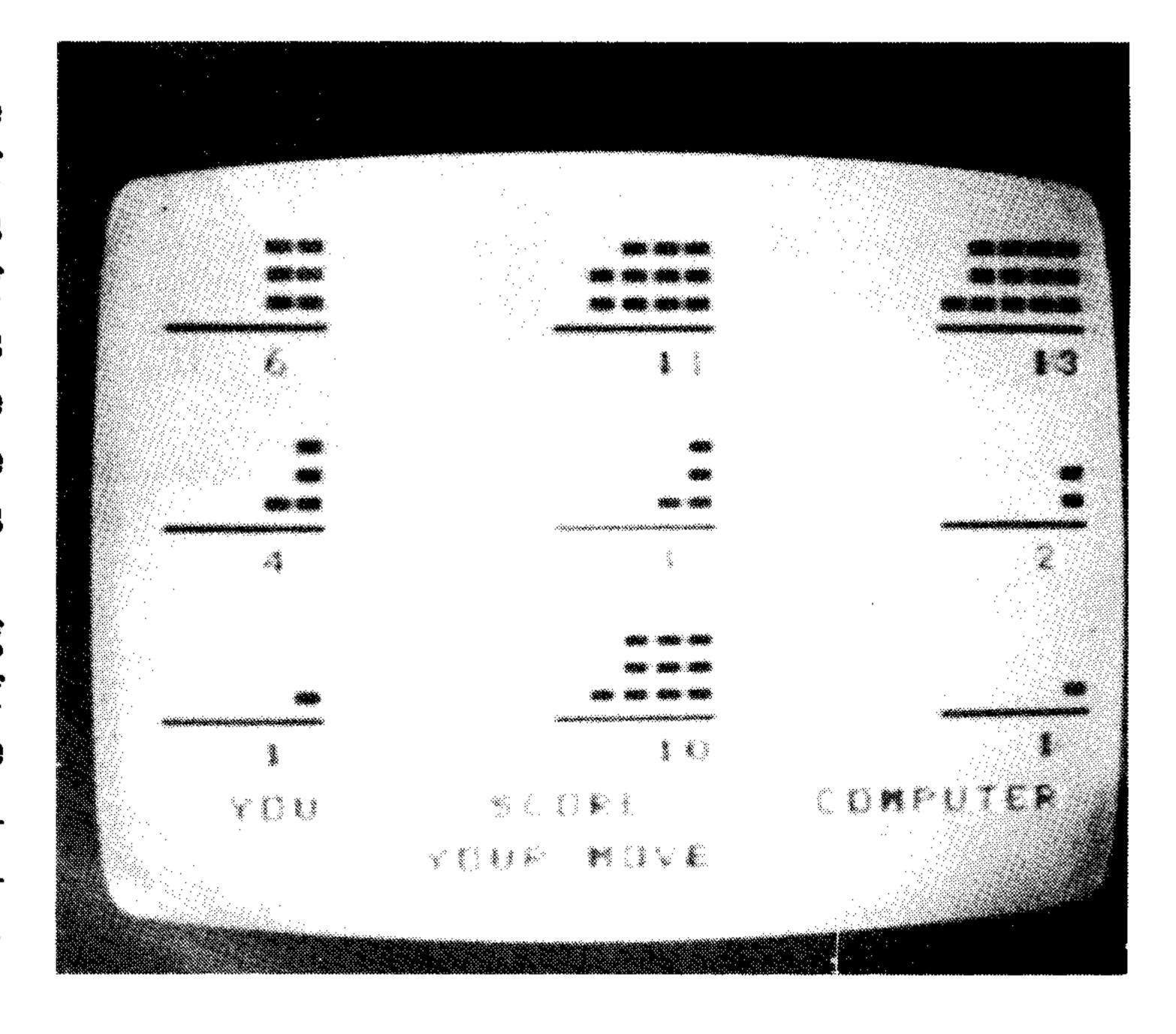
HIDDEN NUMBERS

Behind each of the fifty-four panels lurks a number from one to ten. In this game for one or two players you uncover the numbers two at a time. If they match, you get that many points. A great test of memory. Can you remember where you saw that matching number? Or will the other player remember and get the points? This game requires the joystick accessory for your computer.

NIM

This game program pits you against the computer in the old fashioned game of NIM — the player who gets the last item wins the game. You are given a random number of bricks in each of several piles. Each pile has from one to 15 bricks in it. You choose the number of bricks which you wish to remove from any one pile. The computer then does likewise.

You are given a possible winning combination at the start of the game. But if you make even one mistake during the course of the game, the computer will win. You initially choose 3, 6, or 9 piles of bricks. A real game of mathematical strategy. Joysticks required.

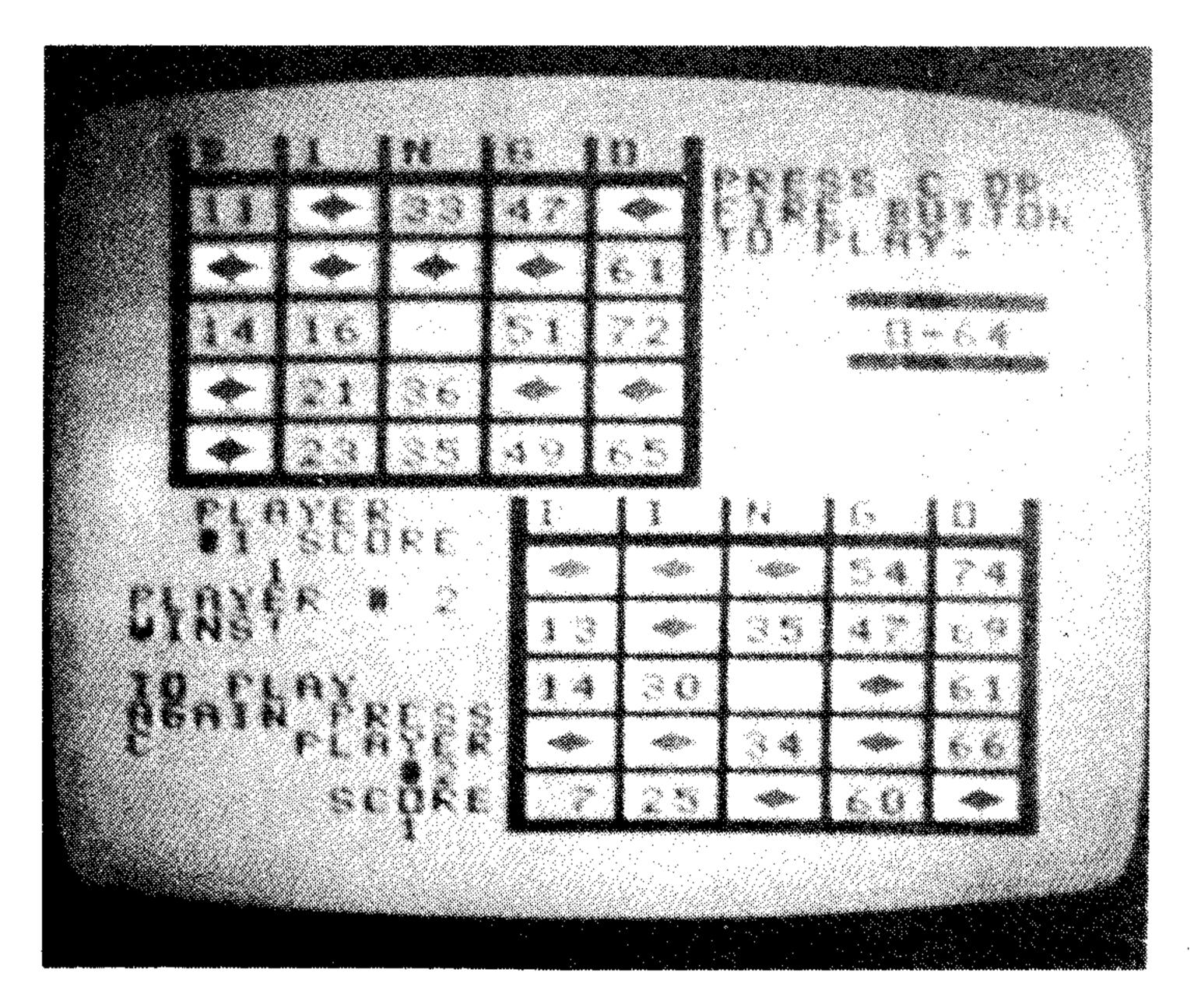


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BINGO

Play against a friend or let the computer play one card while you play the other. Although the speech synthesizer is not required, the game is greatly enhanced by it. Hear each number called plainly. After each number is called, the computer searches both cards and properly places the card markers. Winners are detected automatically by the program and scores of both players are updated after each round of play.

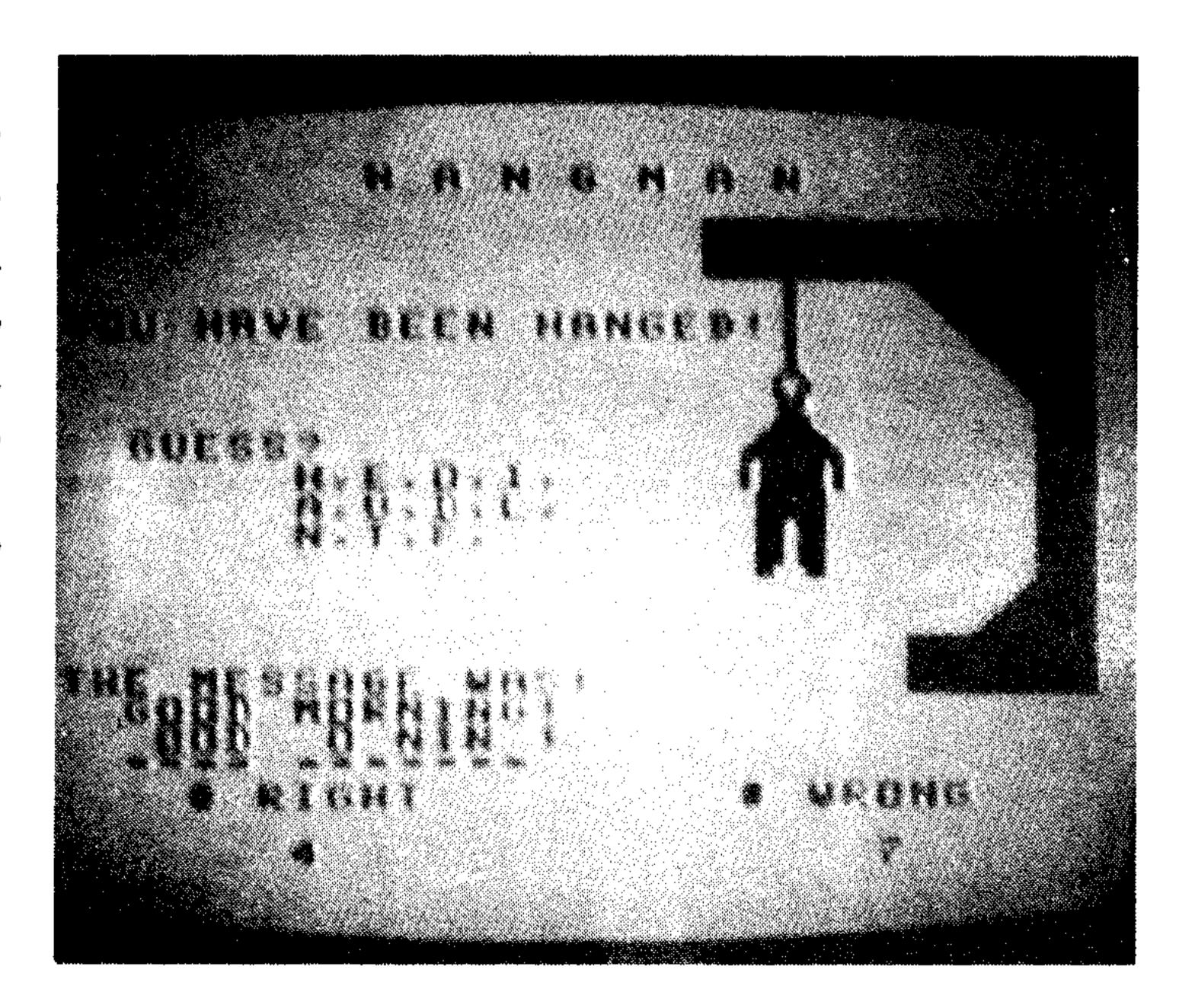
Unlike other Bingo programs, this one does not require a printer. The game is played entirely on your monitor screen.
